

JUNIOR, YOUTH AND INTERMEDIATE MEMBERSHIP FEES, PLAYING RIGHTS & GENERAL INFORMATION

1. **Junior Members** are aged 10 to 17 inclusive. Applicants under 10 can be considered at the discretion of the Management Committee. Holdovers are only granted by direct application to the Management Committee.

2. **Handicap Categories**

There are two handicap categories:-

Cat. 2 Those with a handicap above 19.

Cat. 1 Those with a handicap of 18 and below.

Progress from 2 to 1 shall occur when the lower handicap is attained and on payment of the appropriate fee. Members may choose to remain in the higher category.

3. **Subscriptions**

2017 Subscriptions, according to handicap and age on 1st January are the following:-

4. **Playing Rights**

Girls Competitions

Girls may play in Competitions as determined by the Ladies Committee.

Male Competitions

Category 1 members may play the Course as Adult Members except in the Winter League and on Sunday mornings from 1st November to the 31st March inclusive.

Management Committee agreed (at Nov 2012 meeting) that those members with a CONGU Cat. 1 handicap (i.e. 5 & under) are exempt from these restrictions.

All Club Category 1 members can put their name on the Monday night starting sheet for Sunday morning play from 1st April to the 30th October inclusive.

Category 2

Monday to Friday teeing off before 5 p.m. and

With an Adult Member - after 5 p.m. Monday to Friday

- all day Saturday

- after 2.30 p.m. on Sundays

Category 1

As above *plus*

- After 1 p.m. on a Saturday without an Adult Member

5. **Course Priority**

Unless playing in a competition, all Junior Members must give way on the Course to Adult Members and Visitors.

6. Junior Members may attend and speak at General Meetings but may not vote.

7. **Youth Membership with full playing and voting rights**

Youth Membership (aged 18-25 years old) is available to encourage the participation of young adults. This will be reviewed annually by the Equality Compliance Committee. 2017's subscription is £399.50.

8. **Intermediate Membership** is available for those aged 18-25 years old and who are either on a full-time educational course or on an Apprenticeship Scheme.
 - Details of the course including course completion date are required annually from the course provider.
 - Intermediate Members may play the Course as Adult Members except in the Winter League and on Sunday mornings from 1st November to the 31st March inclusive.
 - Intermediate Members have full voting rights.
2017's fee is £256.50.
 - Intermediate Members may become a Youth member upon completion of their course/scheme or sooner if they wish to have the opportunity to play more golf and upon payment of the relevant subscription.
9. **Guests**
Junior, Youth and Intermediate Members may invite visitors to the Club provided they are members of a recognised Golf Club according to the rules of the Club.
10. Youth and Intermediate Members will then move to **Intermediate Plus** membership (introduced in 2016) which is for members aged between 26 and 30 years. The fee for this category of membership increases dependant on age.
11. Intermediate members may become either Full or 5-Day members of the Club on the 1st January following their 30th birthday on payment of the relevant subscription. The normal Entrance Fee will be reduced by 20% for each year of continuous previous membership up to a maximum of 5 years.
12. All Members must read and uphold the Rules of the Club and the Rules and Etiquette of Golf.
